Please be advised that the prototype large Single Action case, listed as Lot No. 36 of the 1991 R.C.A. "New Year" Mail Auction, was donated by myself to the Ruger Collectors' Association.

This case has the following characteristics and dimensions:


Length: 16-11/16" **Width:** 7-1/2" **Height:** 2-3/4"
Interior Lining: Red Cloth **Bottom Lining:** Purple Velveteen
Hinges: 1-1/4" piano type, 2 each, brass
Catches: Nielsen Hdwe Hartford (spring loaded), 2 each

The case is designed for a large Single Action revolver, with a separate recess for its cylinder, or a spare cylinder.

This case was one offered to the Company for consideration at the time the original Super Blackhawk case factory burned down. It was kept by the Company's former Sales Manager, the late Edward P. Nolan, in a cabinet behind his desk, with other samples of various types, for a number of years. In 1972, Mr. Nolan was cleaning obsolete materials from this cabinet and gave this case to me, as a curio. I have had it, unused, ever since.

The case, including minor mars and scratches, is in the exact condition as at the time when it was given to me by Mr. Nolan.
